FORM TO ENTER A FISH ON THE ISLE OF MAN ROD CAUGHT RECORD FISH LIST

The Isle of Man Angling Federation is responsible for maintaining the Isle of Man rod caught record fish list. If you are fortunate enough to catch, on rod and line, by fair and accepted means, either on the Island or on a boat operating from a Manx Port, a fish that you think may exceed the current Manx record for the species, you should follow the procedure below.

You do not need to be a member of any angling club to claim a Manx record, nor do you need to be a Manx resident. If you are a visitor you are still eligible to claim a Manx record.

To qualify, you need to complete this entry form and take it, and the fish, to the Hon Fish Recorder, Garry Reid, 8 Fenella Terrace, Peel to be weighed and identified. It is recommended you phone first-843682/432370

If there is likely to be a delay before you can take your fish, you should have it weighed on shop scales or the scales of any club affiliated to the Isle of Man Angling Federation and ask the person weighing it to complete the relevant part of the entry form. Having had it so weighed, it must be subsequently submitted to the Hon Fish Recorder for identification as soon as possible.

The committee of the Federation, which meets quarterly, is the body which determines whether your entry can be accepted or not. All new and broken records accepted from the date of this letter will entitle the angler concerned to a certificate, which will be posted to visitors.

Anglers should remember that unless the fish has been identified by the Hon Fish Recorder, the fish cannot be accepted as a record.
